

New forms of employment (relationships)

- Workers employed by contractors
 - Triangular employment relationships
 - Exceeded 1.7 million in 2004
- Economically dependent self-employed workers
 - Not well documented
 - Labour protection often not applicable
 - Should be separated from traditional self-employment
