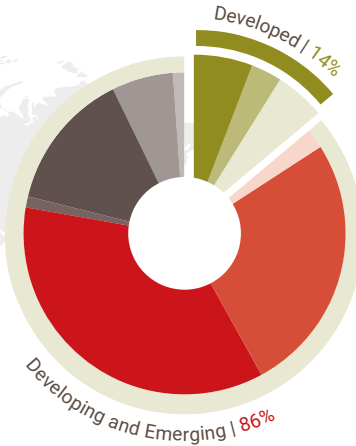


A GLOBAL SNAPSHOT OF HOME-BASED WORKERS

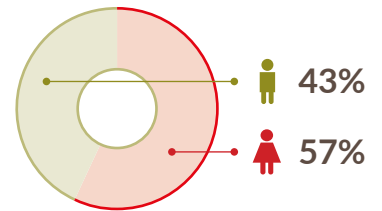
- Europe – 6%

Home-based workers produce goods or provide services from in or around their own home, including in a structure attached to their home.

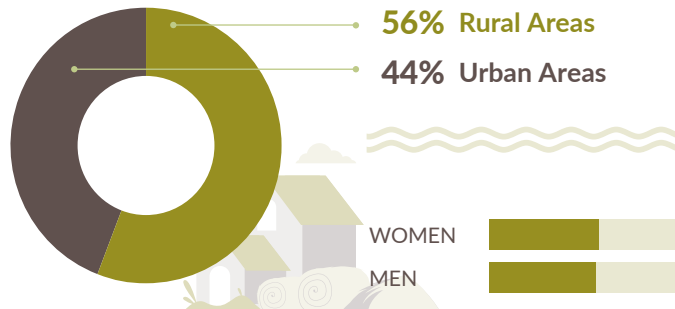
